1. Progress against Plan

- 1.1 The Sub groups analyses of the Adult & Young Person's questionnaires have been forwarded to Planit-X, split under the headings of:
 - 1. Facilities, Business and Services.
 - 2. Traffic & Transport.
 - 3. Housing & Heritage.
 - 4. Renewable Energy, Environment, Open Spaces & Public Rights of Way.
- 1.2 Colin Wilkinson of Planit-X has, after further research, prepared first draft policies in each of the above areas. The whole of the March steering meeting was dedicated to reviewing this work and Colin is now producing a further draft incorporating our observations and thoughts, for the next meeting on the 11th April.
- 1.3 Questionnaire scanning.

This work has been completed and the invoice received. All the questionnaire responses have been scanned and stored along with the Excel data analysis on a DVD. 2 copies have been created and they now reside in the Evidence database
