

Verification of the suggested policies in relation to Traffic and Transport

A review was undertaken of the RCC summary of questionnaire responses dated 7 December 2016 in order to verify the suggested policies set out in the draft SP Neighbourhood Plan v 9 insofar as those policies and the surrounding text relate to traffic and transport.

Suggestions for consideration to be included in the surrounding text are:

- 6.6 some reference to the speeding hotspots being through the villages as well as on the A444 passing through Wellsborough and alongside Sibson and the roads from Sheepy M to Pinwall and to Twycross.
- 6.6 some reference to the dangerous crossroads at Pinwall
- 6.7 whilst there was little support for the chicanes and speedbumps, there was 76% support for vehicle activated speed signage which may be worthy of mention. Fixed speed limit cameras had 52% support. Again, should we consider including a reference to there being some support for fixed speed limit cameras

Somewhere and in some way, we should mention the support of the community for the provision of safe cycle paths and continue to give consideration as to whether we can build a policy around the provision of cycle paths.
